Device Guidelines

We do not endorse any specific mobile device; we merely recommend that it have the following capabilities:

- Internet connectivity (through WiFi or other)
- 6 Hour Battery Life
- Ability to connect to Google Apps for Education
- A Keyboard – integrated, Bluetooth or touch screen
- Word processing capability (more than 1 paragraph visible) - a phone/ipod is not the best tool for this.
- Ability to integrate images, video and sound
- **A phone/ipod is NOT suitable** for word processing, reading textbooks or most other classwork and is not substitute for a device with keyboard and a screen that is at least 9" (11"+ screen size is preferable). **Phones and other small, personal electronics should remain in lockers/away unless specifically requested by teachers.**
