A laptop or Chromebook is encouraged, our school will have alternate technology (although not necessarily 1-1) if bringing your own is not possible

Device Guidelines

We do not endorse any specific device; we merely recommend that it have the following capabilities:

- Internet connectivity (through WiFi or other)
- 6 Hour Battery Life
- Ability to connect to Google Apps for Education
- A separate keyboard
- 9" screen minimum with word processing capability (more than 1 paragraph visible)
- Ability to integrate images, video and sound

A phone/iPod is NOT suitable for word processing, reading textbooks or most other classwork and is not a substitute for a device with a keyboard and a screen that is at least 9" (11"+ screen size is preferable). Phones and other small, personal electronics should remain in lockers/put away unless specifically requested by teachers.
