

BACK TO SCHOOL - September 5, 2023

The following is a list of supplies each Grade 7-8 student **MUST HAVE** to begin the school year. These supplies should last most of the year, although some may need to be replenished from time to time. All the items are necessary as students will use many of them every day.

Students should have their own materials/supplies and avoid sharing with others.

Device Guidelines

CENTENNIAL MIDDLE SCHOOL

We do not endorse any specific device; we merely recommend that it have the following capabilities:

- Internet connectivity (through WiFi or other)
- 6 Hour Battery Life
- Ability to connect to Google Apps for Education
- A separate keyboard
- 9" screen minimum with word processing capability (more than 1 paragraph visible)
- Ability to integrate images, video and sound

A phone/iPad is NOT suitable for word processing, reading textbooks or most other classwork and is not a substitute for a calculator or a device with a keyboard and a screen that is at least 9" (11"+ screen size is preferable). Phones and other small, personal electronics should remain in lockers/away unless specifically requested by teachers.
